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Head Teacher's Report

This is the last newsletter for Term 3 – what an exciting and busy term the children have had.

Literacy Week: This was a great success. Each class contributed to a book they have called "It Wasnae Me" and each part of the story was displayed along the corridor for the Open Day. The book will be published next term and will be available to buy. Some of the pupils will travel to Hamilton to visit the print room whilst their book is being published.

The children also had a workshop with a local author, Janis Mackay, and I understand that there was a bit of a run on her books at the Biggar bookshop!

We finished the week with a visit to the Lanark library, which was very enjoyable. The children developed so many skills during this week and had a lot of fun at the same time. Thanks to Mrs Kilgallon for organising such an exciting event.

The nursery class have been visiting the bookshop in Biggar for a story and to select new books for the nursery.

DYWF event: The P6 pupils joined other P6 classes from the Biggar Learning community to participate in a "Developing the Young Workforce" event. The children worked in mixed teams to complete a number of activities. Lucy McCutcheon was in the winning team and came back to school with a certificate and £10 book voucher. Zoo Lab: We had the opportunity for Zoo Lab to visit us for a morning. This was paid for with the money raised by Mrs Gilbert at Christmas when she hosted her "Meet Santa" event. The children thoroughly enjoyed seeing the insects and reptiles. Thank to Mrs Gilbert for her generosity in providing this experience for the pupils,

Race Night: We had a fantastic family evening at the Race Night and raised £291.22 from the event. Thank you for attending and supporting the Tinto Fund Raisers in this way. 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Pupil power: The pupils at Tinto are a very talented bunch and often take it upon themselves to organise an assembly, lunch club or fund raising event. This month we had a rugby club, a skipping club and a dance club running at lunchtimes. The dance club was organised by Scarlett Cowan, Ella Lamond, Ava Tweedie, Theo Ritchie and Cameron Borthwick - they taught two groups of P1-3 a dance and performed in front of the school. Aiden White and Melissa Brown prepared a powerpoint presentation about looking after the bird nests that are in the bushes. This was also presented to the whole school assembly. Well done – a good example of being a responsible citizen.

Rotary photography competition: The Rotary Club organised a competition for all the primaries in the Learning Community and one of our pupils has won a prize. Congratulations to Grace Johnstone who will receive a certificate and £10 next term.
