Head Teacher's Report







We have now had half a term in the Ridgepark decant and can say with certainty that everyone has settled into the new surroundings. We all felt that we were coming back to familiar territory after the half term break.

Thse of you who have been in or around Symington will have seen that the old building is now being demolished. It is a bit sad to see it go as we have lovely memories of former pupils, staff and events but also exciting as it means the new school will soon start to go up in its place.





New build: I met with the School Modernisation Team just before the October break and an updated plan of the building was discussed. This will be on display during the Open Day on 8.11.16.
