3. Head Teacher Report

Twilight walk – Thank you to the Parent Council and Tinto Fundraisers for their contributions for the event and helping to make it a huge success! At time of print we have raided a total of £8, 355.89.

Staffing – Welcome to Mrs Bowden in P5/6 who is covering Mrs Andrews, and to Miss Jenkins who will be working in the nursery two mornings as well as P1/2 and P2/3 for CCC on a Thursday and Friday afternoon.

Congratulations to Mrs Rodger who is expecting a baby in May.

P.E.F. – This money is mainly being spent on staffing to release Mrs McKillop (previously Mrs Andrews) to support identified children with maths and Mrs Kilgallon with Literacy. This money has also been used to train Mrs Kilgallon and Mrs Baillie in Catch Up Literacy. We

have recently used the money to buy Little Linguist pens to support EAL pupils as well as the teaching of French across all classes.

New Build – Staff had a tour of the building at the beginning of October. Meetings have taken place with the interior designer and our Pupil Council to discuss quotes and graphics.

I.P. - The nursery I.P. is progressing well. The EYW are working on creativity in the nursery setting and possible home – school links. The team leaders and N.T. are working on literacy and numeracy bags to take home.

Biggar, Carnwath and Tinto have been working on ways to support pupils with their writing. We have been developing literacy mats to support all genres and to allow pupils to evaluate and self-check their work.

All classes continue to use maths strategies/ numicon developed last term.

The Learning Community are working together to develop a directory listing all the careers/jobs that exist in the L.C. which we can then use when planning DYWF/ Enterprise projects in the future.

Staff are continuing to work on moderating planners and assessments together, on familiarisation of the SLC tracking formats and with the SNSA national assessments
