Head Teacher's Report

New build update: The new school is coming on well. The walls are going up and some windows are in! There is a meeting with the graphic artist on the 28th September to discuss which quotes will be going on the walls and what graphics we want in the hall. Staff may be able to have a site visit at the beginning of October. If all goes to plan, we are hoping to be in the new building at the start of the summer term. You will be able to see the progress for yourself when you come along to Parents Evening- if it's not too dark!

Open Day: Thank you for attending the open day this month. It is always lovely to see the families being shown around the school by their children. It is also a way of maintaining the school:home partnership with the school being based in Lanark.

P.C AGM: Thank you to the committee members and teachers who were able to attend the AGM. It was very disappointing that no one from the parent forum was able to attend. This was an opportunity to show appreciation of the additional work the members of the Parent Council do for the benefit of the pupils. The minutes and AGM report will be on the website.

P1 curriculum meeting: This was organised by Mrs Kilgallon and Mrs Rodger and time was spent updating leaflets and gathering resources. Unfortunately no one was able to attend due to work commitments etc. We have asked for suggestions for alternative times to meet with parents.
